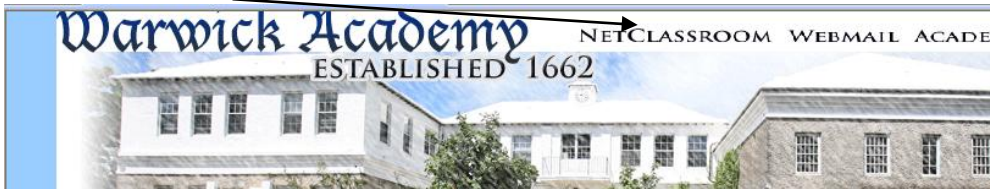


NetClassroom

NetClassroom is the online tool we use to convey reporting (Primary and Secondary), major assignment and test information (Secondary) to parents and students.

To access student information you will need to follow the steps below:

1. Open the school webpage: www.warwickacad.bm (preferably using Internet Explorer).
2. Click on the **NetClassroom** icon at the top of the page



3. Enter your unique **User ID** and **Password** to access the system. If you have lost or cannot remember these details please contact Sue Fitzsimmons (sfitzsimmons@warwickacad.bm) for Secondary queries or Melissa Ferreira (mferreira@warwickacad.bm) for Primary.

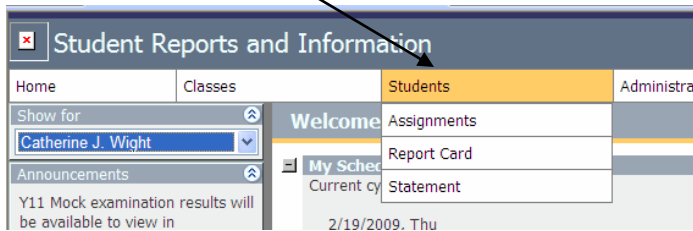

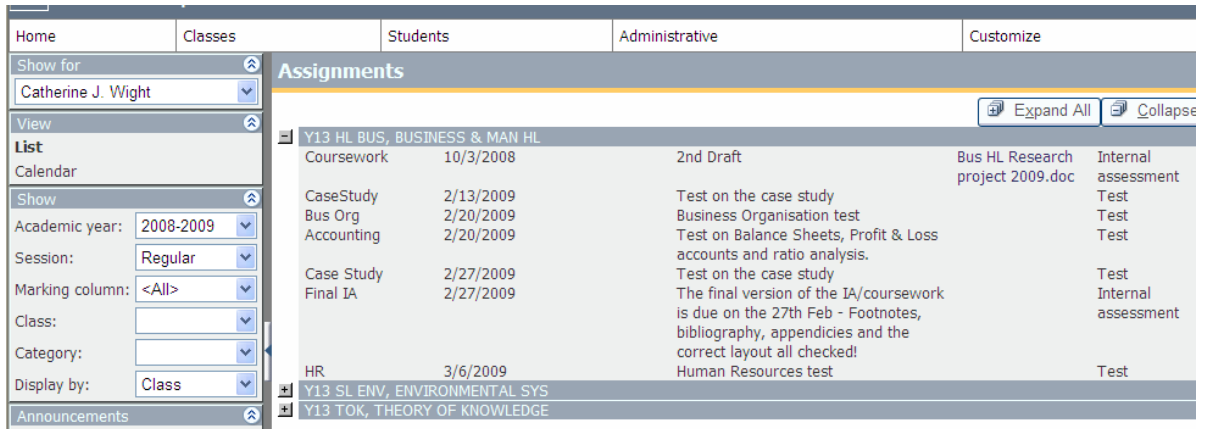

You will notice schedule and assignment information on the home page as well as relevant announcements on the left hand side.

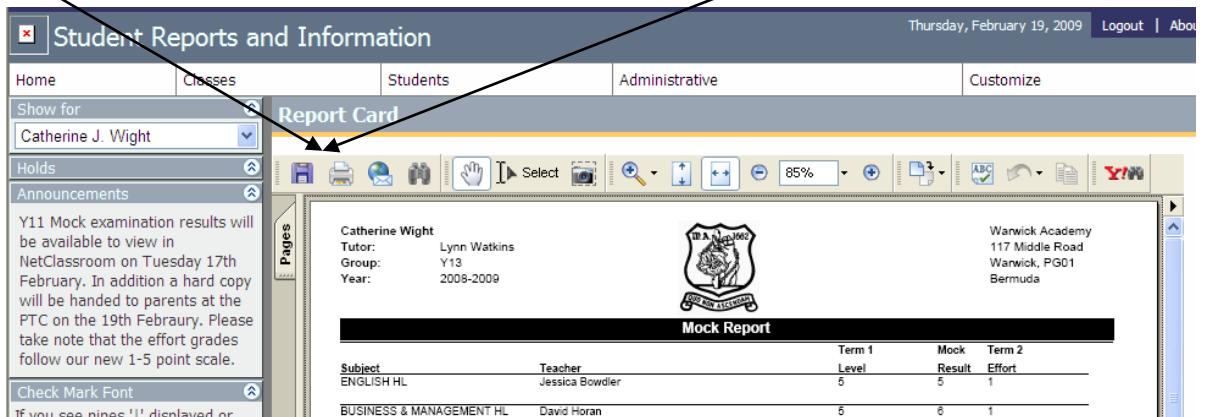
5. By clicking on **Students** you can then choose to view assignments or the most recent report card.



6. The **assignments** page will give you information pertaining to tests and major assignments – expect between 3 to 7 major assignments per term. This information will include a due date and some basic information. **Please note that the homework diary must still be used for recording this and the regular (nickel & dime type) homework at school.**



7. The **report card** page will display the latest report and this should be saved on your home PC or printed out – there is no area to save past report cards in NetClassroom.
